The State Library's new Kansas Virtual Library online audio-book service is giving Kansas residents access to popular audio-books from any Internet-connected PC computer. OverDrive, Inc., a leading vendor of audio book solutions for libraries, supplied the technology for the new service.

The Kansas Virtual Library online audio-books are available to anyone with a Kansas Library Card. The Kansas Virtual Library's audio-books can be read on many MP3 players, PDAs, Pocket PCs, and Smartphones, in addition to PCs or laptop PCs. (But not on iPods or Macs.)

The Library's audio-book collection includes NY Times Bestsellers Most Circulated Audio, Children/Juvenile Fiction, Foreign Language Study, Fiction, Business, and Self-Help titles. Music titles are also in the collection, such as Naxos Classical Music "Must-Have" titles, and the 50 Best Selling Albums from Magnatune, including Rock, Jazz/Blues, New-Age, and Classical.
